Entrance notice

BEFORE ENTERING THE PRACTICE

Please ensure you can answer no to the following questions:

- (1) Have you been diagnosed with having Covid-19 in the last 30 days?
- (2) Have you experienced a recent onset of respiratory problems, such as a persistent/regular cough or difficulty in breathing within the past 14 days?
- (3) Have you come into contact with a patient with confirmed Covid-19 infection within the past 14 days?
- (4) Do you have a fever or experienced a fever within the past 14 days?
- (5) Have you, within the past 14 days, travelled abroad or outside of the UK?

- (6) Have you been in close contact with anyone who is or has experienced a fever or respiratory problems within the last 14 days?
- (7) Have you recently participated in any large gathering, meetings, or had close contact (within 2m) with many unacquainted people?

If the answer is yes to any of the above, do not enter the practice but call us on 01458 840033

If you are making a delivery and you have answered no to the above questions, please come in but do not approach the reception desk and you will receive instructions from the receptionist.

WHAT TO DO WHEN **ENTERING THE PRACTICE**



1 SANITISE YOUR HANDS Using the soap dispenser provided



2 PUT ON THE FACE MASK

Staff will tell you how to install your mask correctly - Please take your mask with you when you leave



3 REMOVE YOUR OUTER GARMENT

Place any belongings in the marked white box situated by the entrance



4 PUT ON THE SHOE COVERS

Please dispose of these in the white bin by the entrance when you leave



5 SANITISE YOUR HANDS AGAIN

Once you have done this, Please sit in the grey armchair nearest to the entrance

How to Handwash

WASH HANDS WHEN VISIBLY SOILED! OTHERWISE, USE HANDRUB

Duration of the entire procedure: 40-60 seconds




Wet hands with water;



Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces;



Rub hands palm to palm;



Right palm over left dorsum with interlaced fingers and vice versa;



Palm to palm with fingers interlaced;



Backs of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlocked;



Rotational rubbing of left thumb clasped in right palm and vice versa;



Rotational rubbing, backwards and forwards with clasped fingers of right hand in left palm and vice versa;




Rinse hands with water;



Dry hands thoroughly with a single use towel;



Use towel to turn off faucet;



Your hands are now safe.
